

Instructions for Submission of Abstracts, Papers and Technology Presentation Synopses for the Tenth DST Group International Conference on Health and Usage Monitoring Systems (HUMS2017)

Templates

Click on the menu list on the left side of [this page](#) to download templates. Note there are currently TWO lists as the method will vary slightly with browser and Operating System. Earlier Microsoft Internet Explorer does NOT support HTML5 Download Button as used by Google Chrome and Others. If another window opens, save the file and close that window to return here.

Use the appropriate template to create a Word file for submission. If you cannot access Word or OpenOffice writer, then you may submit as a text readable pdf. NOTE pdf submissions will only be accepted via email to papers@HUMSconference.com.au. Your submission should include a title, author and affiliation, and abstract (200 words max.).

Submission

Submission is via the AIAC17 Congress portal, except as noted above. Follow the instructions and links on the AIAC17 website ([here](#)). The "Abstract Submission" menu item on the [Links](#) page will take you directly to the portal. For convenience, a menu item for the Links page is included on the menu on [this page](#).

During the submission process, in the TOPICS section, choose the stream "Health & Usage Monitoring Systems". In the AVALON OR AIAC section, make the appropriate selection for whether you are submitting a paper at the conference in Melbourne, or a technology presentation at the Avalon Airshow. Note that some organisations may wish to present both a paper at the conference in Melbourne and a technology presentation at the Avalon Airshow. In this case submit two separate abstracts, one for the paper and one for the technology presentation.

Late submissions will only be accepted by email to papers@HUMSconference.com.au and only at the discretion of the HUMS2017 Committee.
